Thank you for your leadership and devotion to public service. On behalf of the Pennsylvania Bus Association and the Greater New Jersey Motorcoach Association, we implore you to help control fuel costs by enacting critical reforms to the federal Renewable Fuel Standard (RFS) for domestic oil refineries. Our industry depends on them to produce countless products that help Americans in limitless ways.

Without reforms, runaway compliance costs for the RFS would damage the ability of thousands of our members to deliver affordable services to the many customers we serve across Pennsylvania and New Jersey. Our members, and their thousands of employees, provide private coach services that deliver tremendous tourism and economic development benefits. We all understand the good intentions of RFS, but the cost of the mandate now dwarfs all other costs for the regional refineries critical to fueling Pennsylvania and New Jersey.
