

STATEMENT BY THE FUELING AMERICAN JOBS COALITION

February 19, 2021 – The Fueling American Jobs Coalition released the following statement regarding the Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) request for comment regarding Petitions for a Waiver of the 2019 and 2020 Renewable Fuel Standards:

"EPA and the entirety of the Biden Administration should advance policies that keep the refining sector competitive in the international marketplace. A robust refining sector is essential not only to the Administration's energy security and job creation objectives, but also to the clean-energy and climate change agenda. Any reduction in greenhouse gases will require new generations of liquid motor fuels that necessitate economically healthy and competitive refineries."

The Fueling American Jobs Coalition is a coalition of union workers, mom & pop gas station owners, small retailers, and independent American oil refiners fighting for a commonsense fix to the Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA's) flawed Renewable Fuel Standard (RFS). The need for significant reform has only grown over the past few years as the cost of purchasing Renewable Identification Numbers (RINs) to comply with the RFS has grown increasingly volatile, threatening some refiners' survival.
