

STATEMENT BY THE FUELING AMERICAN JOBS COALITION

May 17, 2019- The Fueling American Jobs Coalition released the following statement on today's DC Circuit denial of a motion for injunction against EPA filed by the Advanced Biofuels Association:

"The US Court of Appeals for the DC Circuit denied the biofuel lobby's request for an injunction against EPA following clear precedent in granting small refinery exemptions under the renewable fuel program. Under standards applied by the Court, it seems as though the biofuels lobby couldn't prove they were significantly harmed or that they were likely to succeed on the merits, or both. This denial can now be added to the clear direction given by the judiciary and Congress to EPA establishing that SREs must be granted upon demonstration of disproportionate economic hardship for small refineries—the test in the Clean Air Act. The FAJC looks forward to EPA reaching timely decisions on pending SRE applications."
