



Trump Meeting Should Make RFS More Rational

February 27, 2018 – The Fueling American Jobs Coalition released the following statement on today’s meeting at the White House led by President Trump on RFS reforms:

“Members of the Fueling American Jobs Coalition were informed that President Trump led a meeting Tuesday of key Senators and senior Administration officials to resolve significant problems associated with implementation of the renewable fuels standard, or RFS. The President’s leadership, coupled with that of Senators Cruz and Toomey, and the active participation of Senators Ernst and Grassley, holds the promise of bringing RFS reform in a direction that brings rationality to RFS trading credits, called RINs, while assisting the biofuel industry in developing and expanding markets. Today’s meeting represents clear forward momentum towards a durable solution.

Tens of thousands of direct and indirect refining jobs in Pennsylvania, Texas and across the country will benefit if the President provides clear direction on administrative adjustments to the RFS program. We look forward to working with Administrator Pruitt, Secretary Perdue and others senior Administration officials on the details of a sensible solution.”
